"Several months ago, Calvary attendee Brooks Way approached me with the idea of taking some acoustic guitars down to the Rose of Sharon Orphanage in the Dominican Republic. A few of the young men have begun to lead worship and the organization has hired a music teacher for the students. Brooks thought that some of the young men might be interested in learning to play guitar. I loved the idea of teaching them to play, and I quickly agreed to see what we could do.

I posted a note on Facebook seeking unused/unwanted acoustics. Within a few weeks leads turned up! I went to the music store to buy several sets of strings (you have no idea how hard those boys are on things!) and stopped to price some cheap acoustic guitars while I was there. I fully expected to take four acoustics with us. But as things sometimes go, a few of the leads turned out to be dead ends. The day before our trip, I had two guitars in hand. To be honest, I was a little disappointed. 'Don't worry about a thing,' Brooks said. 'We'll take whatever the Lord gives us, and the boys will be thrilled.'

The morning before we left, Lilly's small group from XStream held a car wash to raise support for us to buy supplies in the DR. It was hot, and we had a blast! The girls (and Levi!) worked hard, raising more than \$800! On top of that, a generous man from Calvary stopped by with an envelope for me. He told me that he didn't know the first thing about buying guitars, but he had some money that might help us get what we wanted. I opened the envelope, and there looking back at me was \$500!

I headed back to the music store, told the owner what I was hoping to do and he hooked me up with a deal. For less than \$500, I walked out of the store with two guitars, straps, bags to carry the guitars, and a sweet tuner.

I don't know if that qualifies as a miracle, but it sure is evidence that God provides what we need. It may not always come as quickly as we think it ought to, but God's provision is never a moment too late."
