How do you put into words the impact that a sports camp has on the eternal destiny of kids? Researcher George Barna tells us that 43% of all Americans who follow Jesus (nearly half!) do so before reaching the age of 13. So when 133 campers show up at Sports Camp to participate in their favorite sport and to talk about the greatest story ever told, you can count on the mark of Jesus being left on their heart and life!

At Calvary Sports Camp 2009, 133 preschool through 5th grade kids (82 from Calvary, 51 from beyond our Calvary walls) energetically showed up not only to participate in sport instruction but to end each night hearing the story of Jesus and enthusiastically singing and shouting songs about His love and power. You can count on His mark being left on their spirit.

When 65 adult and teenage volunteers come together to serve kids for three hours each night, you can literally see their love, as God's love, leaving a mark on their campers.

When the generosity of our Calvary family provides camp scholarships for 10 kids, you can see the mark of Jesus in the eyes of grateful parents or guardians.

When 12 of 133 campers put their faith in Jesus and make a first time decision to follow Him, you know they bear the mark of hope that Jesus offers in salvation.

When 32 other kids say that they "understand what it means to follow Jesus better" after Sports Camp, the mark of His calling becomes more visible in their lives.

When half of the kids listen to a Penn State football player tell his story of faith in knowing Jesus and about being baptized in believers baptism as a child and 13 of those kids are baptized in later months, they are marked by evidence of being on God's team.

Sports Camp leaves a mark on kids for eternity and thus, God becomes more famous in the Centre Region and beyond.
