SERMON NOTES

Mark 10:17-31 • Vic King

¹⁷As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to him and fell on his knees before him. “Good teacher,” he asked, “what must I do to inherit eternal life?”

¹⁸“Why do you call me good?” Jesus answered. “No one is good—except God alone. ¹⁹You know the commandments: ‘Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, do not defraud, honor your father and mother.’”

²⁰“Teacher,” he declared, “all these I have kept since I was a boy.”

²¹Jesus looked at him and loved him. “One thing you lack,” he said. “Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.”

²²At this the man’s face fell. He went away sad, because he had great wealth.

²³Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, “How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!”

²⁴The disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus said again, “Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! ²⁵It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.”

²⁶The disciples were even more amazed, and said to each other, “Who then can be saved?”

²⁷Jesus looked at them and said, “With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God.”

²⁸Peter said to him, “We have left everything to follow you!”

²⁹“I tell you the truth,” Jesus replied, “no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel ³⁰will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age (homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields—and with them, persecutions) and in the age to come, eternal life. ³¹But many who are first will be last, and the last first.”

"One Sunday, my family woke up at 8:15 after a late Saturday night. My husband had been on call and it had been an especially busy week! I was out late with a friend in crisis so I woke up feeling tired and lazy with only 45 minutes to get ready for church. I decided to tell my husband we would stay home but a voice in my head said, 'Get up, get dressed, and don't say anything.' I don't often pay attention to those promptings but for some reason, I did. My husband woke up melancholy but somehow we all got ready for church in less than 45 minutes (a first!).

During the sermon, a young boy behind us passed out. Being a doctor, my husband responded immediately. At the same time, Dr. Martin offered to help. Interestingly, my husband had just met Dr. Martin in the hospital the week before when they discovered that they both went to Calvary. So there was no need for introductions or explanations ... God had covered those bases before this incident.

The boy was taken out and soon my husband sat back down beside me. He was shaking as he wrote on my sermon notes, 'Lying in bed this morning, I knew this was going to happen. God told me.' When we left, he told me that he woke up that morning he thought, 'I'm tired. My wife got home late. We won't go to church today.' A voice said to him, 'Get up, get dressed, someone is going to need your help in church today.' He argued with his thoughts, 'I was on call last week. I'm tired. It's a big church, someone else will help. If my wife says anything to me about not going, I'll agree with her...'

We just stared at each other realizing what had happened, this was a God-story. Connecting the incident with other similar incidents recently, we were speechless and humbled. We both keep hearing "this voice" that leads to necessary connections that lead to some God moment/God interaction/God-controlled circumstance. This is only one story. There have been multiple incidents - same idea, same voice, given to both of us at the same time. I don't know exactly how or why God does what He does, but I am increasingly amazed, overly humbled, and trying to listen more."
